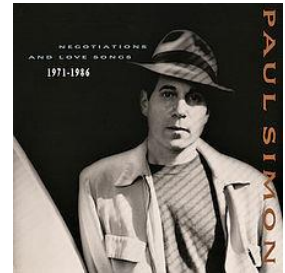
Chorus:
